The following courses, open to grades 9 – 12, are proposed for students to choose from. They will meet weekly, days and times to be determined. **Please indicate which class student chooses and day/time that would be best for you. The courses to be offered depend upon the responses received before September 16th:**

- I. **Apologetics** - The understanding of the Catholic religion with a view to defending the Faith from specific objections.
- II. **Mass and Sacraments** - The liturgical and sacramental economy of the Catholic Church; its theological, spiritual, and historical place in Divine Revelation and in the economy of salvation.
- III. **Catholic Morality** - Ethics of a good life and the principles and practices of Christian living. Specific advantages, issues, and objections to obeying the moral law and living a life of grace.
- IV. **Christian Spirituality*** - Prayer and a life of intimacy with God. How to establish a practical and fruitful prayer life with Father, Son, and Holy Spirit from the teaching of Jesus Christ according to the Catholic tradition. ***taught by Fr. Melmer**
- V. **Scripture** - The Word and Revelation of God in the Bible. Scripture and Tradition, and the interpretation of the Bible in the Catholic Tradition.
- VI. **Events and Sources in the Catholic Tradition** - Key sources of Catholic Faith and spirituality in their historical context, with an overview of the eras and seminal events of Church history.
- VII. **Person of Jesus Christ** - Only Son of the Father, Creator, Incarnate Word, Savior, Lord, Lamb of God, friend and brother.
- VIII. **LifeWork** - Finding your unique purpose in life. Utilizing the series authored by Rick Sarkisian and published by *Ignatius Press*, the course will focus on human and spiritual formation and growth, and discovering one's true vocation in the Catholic Church today.
- IX. **Christian Marriage and Bioethics*** - Catholic teaching on nature, man, and woman and the vocation to love in the Sacrament of Marriage. The transmission of human life and the dignity of the human person. ***Juniors and Seniors only**
