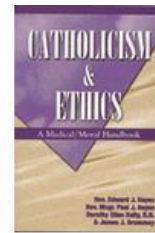
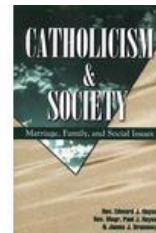
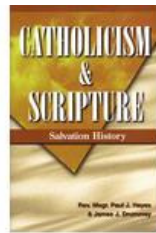
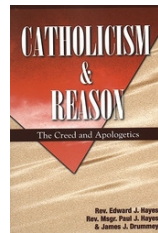
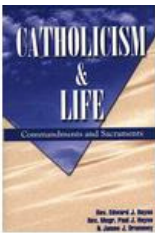
St. John's Religious Ed will be offering Two High School Programs in 2012-2013

Both sets of classes will be held in St. John's School

High School course of study currently offered

This course is for all high school students. It will continue to cover the Catholicism series by Rev. Edward J. Hayes, Rev. Msgr. Paul J. Hayes, & James J. Drummey. High School Honors Program

This fall we will begin offering a new High School Honor's Program where interested students may select one of their four years of study to be a member. This new year long program will begin Sept. 10th, 2012 and will consist of 4 short courses covering:

Church Architecture



Church Literature



Church Art

Unlike the other four years, this program will involve local road trips for the four fields of study as well as a three day weekend (*leaving late afternoon 1/19/13 and returning 1/21/13*) road trip to Philadelphia and New York in order to help synthesize the elements of study. The parents of the students are welcome to join on the trips. High School students interested in this program are will be required to take the **Entrance Test which will be offered on 2 dates: Monday, 5/14 & 8/13** at 5pm in the school.
